Covid prevention measures v 2 - November 2021

The Council's intention is that the following precautions will allow us all to feel as confident and comfortable as we can to allow us to dance normally, i.e. normal sized sets, no masks and hands taken as dictated by the dance.

We request everyone planning to attend classes and social events for the foreseeable future to adhere to the following:

- We recommend that you should have been vaccinated twice and have had a booster if offered
- Do not attend class if feeling unwell
- Bring your own sanitiser. Sanitiser will also be available in the hall by the ladies toilet and also by the shutter to the kitchen.
- Use hand gel and wash hands frequently
- Biscuits will be provided but bring your own snack if you want to. Tea, coffee and water will be provided.
- Socially distance when not dancing, to assist everyone to feel comfortable.
- Aim to bring the correct money for the class fee to reduce handling.
- Ideally one person at a time in the toilet- wait in the entrance hall, not the wash basin area.
- Plenty of ventilation, open windows and doors - so please remember to bring appropriate layers of clothing

The requirements of the hall owners are:

- There is a one way system- enter by the main door, leave by the doors in the hall into the car park.
- They are also advising the door(s) from the lobby into the hall are kept open for improved ventilation, and also to open a window or two if not too cold

Please notify the Secretary if you test positive for Covid within two weeks of attending a class or event.
